Sydney University Swimming Club's Parent & Carers Codes of Conduct are:

- a) Encourage swimmers to participate in sport for their individual enjoyment, personal satisfaction and improvement
- b) Focus on swimmer's effort, application and achievement of their own goals
- c) Congratulate all participants on their swim
- d) Treat all swimmers with respect and dignity, regardless of performance
- e) Be an example to all swimmers, appreciating good performance and behaviour by all swimmers
- f) Support all efforts to remove bullying, harassment and abuse from the sporting environment
- g) Encourage swimmers to accept feedback and coaching, to abide by the rules and accept judgements made by officials
- h) Allow the coach to coach and support the coach's efforts in developing all swimmers
- i) Appreciate, respect and value everyone involved in our sport
- j) Remember that your child participates in sport for their own enjoyment.
